**Applications for waivers of work day/working hours requirements may be made to the secretary of the Department of Labor but must list specific dates and times for specifically named minors.

*Days during which school is considered to be in session are determined by the school district in which the minor resides.

Meals: (LA Revised Statutes, Article 2, Sec. 213)

- one 30 minute interval within any five hour period
- meal period is not included as part of the working hours of the day

Education: (LA Revised Statutes, Article 51, Sec. 2134)

- if a minor is absent from school for **2 or more days within a 30 day period**, the employer shall employ a certified teacher beginning on the second day of employment
- a minimum of **3 education instruction hours per day** to the minor pursuant to the lesson plans for the particular minor as provided by the principal and teachers at the minor's school
- a teacher to student ratio of **one teacher for every ten students**
